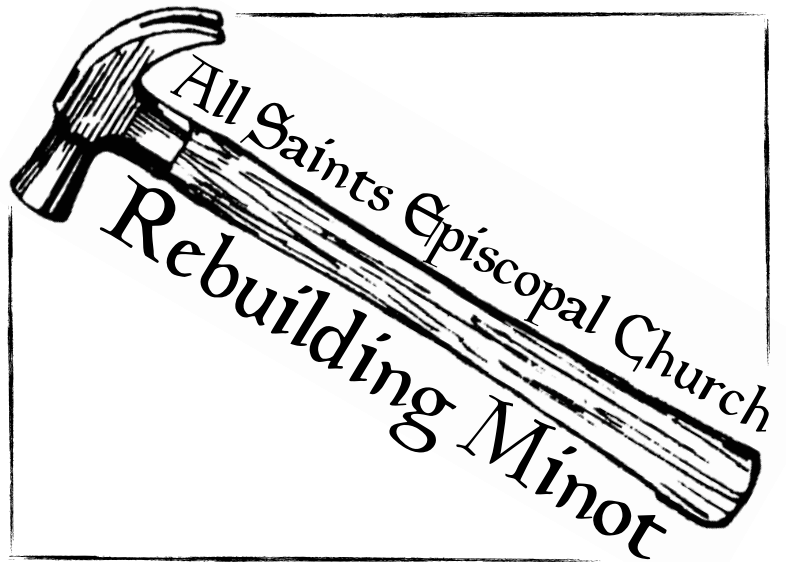


# We are ready!
